SUBJECT: REMOVAL OF NAME FROM ADDRESS PLATES AND FILES

Donald Kingsbury, teaching in the Math Dept. of McGill University in Toronto is to be removed from all address and membership files.

For some years I have watched McGill University mysteriously giving out Scientology data to the press as its own.

A booklet published by Kingsbury using Scientology instruction data - and squirrelling it - without credit has just appeared as "his own development."

No books or other data may be sold or forwarded this person and any membership he holds should be cancelled.

If there is a complaint from this person he must be told he cannot be restored to communication until he has had auditing in Washington at his own expense and if he does take auditing only definitions of terms in his own fields may be run on him.

This does not have sufficient importance to merit a Committee of Evidence.

This is the routine pattern of handling all such persons who squirrel with Scientology data or publish data without credit to Scientology.

The explanation usually offered is "I wanted to edge up on people, so I didn't want to use the word Scientology" has neither validity nor truth. The truth is

(a) Such people haven't understood our nomenclature and

(b) They haven't grasped the nomenclature of other fields contacted long before they met us.

A Committee of Evidence may be convened on the authority of the Continental Director U.S. but only if Kingsbury (or such persons) demands it when informed of his rights.

There is no obligation to inform such a person of our action as we can do business or communicate with whom we please.
